4. Report back on Boroondara Council and other events attended

Report back on events attended -

Boroondara Council: Sports Club Forum - Women and Girls Fair Access Policy Deidre attended the online Fair Access Policy forum on 26 June. This is a priority for state and local governments. Overall sports participation in Victoria is higher for males (17%) than females (9%). Women are 2.5 times more likely to report feeling unwelcome at their sporting club compared to men.

Some of the messages were to:

- Maintain supportive committees that are open to learning and welcoming new committee members
- Consult with members with surveys, informal conversations
- Consider the needs of the entire club, e.g. women are generally less focussed on competition, and
- Small changes can make a big difference.

CPC is performing well against the policy objectives, with women making up over 50% of club members and 50% of committee members. CPC also balances competitive and social play and activities to seek to meet a wide range of members' needs.

Boroondara Council: Men's Health innovation Workshop
Bob attended this forum on 7 May, which had a focus on encouraging men over
35 to participate in social activities to support mental health and ageing well. Bob
advised the forum that CPC welcomes new members and pétanque is an
opportunity to engage in competitive sport at any age.

Community Forum at Lynden Park

John Pesutto, MP Member for Hawthorn held a community forum at Lynden Park Recreational Facility on Tuesday 16 July. Mr Pesutto's office had invited CPC to attend the event. Bob attended representing the club.

5. Committee role statements

Role statements provide clarity about committee and other roles, which may change depending on the interests and skills of incumbents. They are useful when inducting new committee members. Deidre has sent a link to draft role statements for President, Treasurer, Secretary, Membership Officer, Communications Officer and Tournament Director.
