Focus for next 12 months

Following is a list of items members raised and outcomes:

Hi Bob and Paul

I hate to raise things after the committee meeting but I have had some time to think about the date of the tournament and wanted to run this by you both

I wonder if you would consider changing the date to 30 November?

I understand why we are limited to dates for the club tournament having looked at the My Petanque listings and seeing the high level of our members participation in competitions until the end of the year. I propose November 30 because competitions end the week before so there is no clash.

My worry is that by having it on the same day as the cards night we risk having less people at both.

As I read the blurb going in the newsletter for the cards it is <u>not</u> about a small group of players its about getting all members including non card players as well to come along for a social night. I am concerned that players who would be interesting in doing both would be forced to chose one activity. This includes Leigh, Jenny and Heinz who are running the cards but I am thinking more broadly of members who we are trying to encourage to play tournaments and who may chose a social night instead. Similarly, we don't want to set up a social night for failure by creating the clash - this would be disappointing for Leigh Heinz and Jenny and not the way we want to treat committed volunteers.

I also think a big lead up to the tournament with more time to promote and plan would increase the participation. Having it a week before the Xmas party means we could potentially create the athletic awards from the results from the tournament(and the ladder) making it a lot easier to manage and more relevant to club members.

Anyway please let me know your thoughts . Happy to chat if you prefer phone to email Should you agree to the change I will then forward to all committee members.
